

Highlights of the Pilgrimage ...Follow the footsteps of St. Thomas More and St. John Fisher. Learn about St. Simon Stock and the origin of the brown scapular. View the best surviving copy of the Magna Carta, the document that laid the groundwork for religious freedom today. Meet some notable alumni of Oxford University, John Henry Cardinal Newman, C.S. Lewis, J.R.R. Tolkien. Also meet a 14th century mystic still revered for her meditations on a series of private revelations from Our Lord, Jesus. We will journey from the thriving city center of London to the rural English countryside. Our pilgrimage will be led by School of Faith theologian, Dr. Troy Hinkel and Monsignor Stuart Swetland, S.T.D, President of Donnelly College, and a graduate of Oxford University.



Day to Day Itinerary

Day 1 May 27

Depart US on overnight flight to London. Dinner and breakfast in transit.

Day 2 May 28

London

D

We arrive in London and are met by our local tour escort who will accompany us throughout our stay in England. Since we arrive early in the day, we will take some time viewing the highlights of London until our rooms are prepared for check-in. Our private Mass is to be confirmed. The balance of the day is free until we gather for a welcome dinner in a local restaurant or pub. Overnight in London

Day 3 May 29

London: St. Thomas More

B

We will spend this day getting to know the London life of St. Thomas More. Milk Street, a prosperous residential area, where Thomas More was born; St. Lawrence Jewry, his family parish church, where he lectured as a young lawyer on Augustine's City of God; the Guildhall (with a fine stained glass window of More) where More served as undersheriff. While studying law at Charterhouse, More received spiritual guidance at the strict Carthusian Monastery. Lincoln's Inn, where More was a student, lecturer and then governing officer. St. Paul's (Christopher Wren's masterpiece now the Anglican Cathedral), where More's good friend and spiritual advisor, Fr. John Colet, was rector. Blackfriars, where, in 1523, Thomas More served as speaker of the House of Commons. Our private Mass is to be confirmed. Dinner is on your own. Overnight in London

Day 4 May 30

London: Excursion to Canterbury

B, D

Travel into the Kent countryside to Aylesford and Faversham, for a visit and Mass at the chapel of Our Lady of Mount Carmel where the Blessed Virgin presented the Brown Scapular to St. Simon Stock and the National Shrine to St. Jude. After visiting Mount Carmel, we go to Rochester, home of St. John Fisher. Bishop Fisher was the only Bishop in England who (with Thomas More), opposed King Henry VIII. Then drive to Canterbury to see the place where St. Thomas Beckett was martyred at the hands of King Henry II in 1170. The history of Canterbury dates to the time of St. Augustine who brought Christianity to England in 597. Return to London for group dinner and overnight.

Day 5 May 31

Stonehenge – Salisbury - Bath

B, D

We head west for a visit to Bath stopping on the way at Stonehenge to visit the ancient monoliths placed in position nearly 2,000 years before the birth of Christ. We then cross Salisbury Plain to pay a visit to Salisbury Cathedral, known as the Cathedral Church of the Blessed Virgin Mary before being taken over by the Church of England. In addition to having the tallest church spire in the UK (404') and the world's oldest working clock (from AD 1386), the cathedral has the best surviving of the four original copies of the Magna Carta. This document, the Great Charter, established the principle that everyone is subject to law, even Kings. The Bill of Rights, the first thirteen amendments to the US Constitution, was influenced by the Magna Carta. From Salisbury we drive on to Bath, named after the hot springs first used by the Romans, it is one of the most beautiful Georgian cities in England. Our private Mass in Bath is to be confirmed. Overnight in Bath with group dinner at our hotel.

Day 6 June 1 Oxford – Stratford-Upon-Avon B

This morning we travel to Oxford where Thomas More studied for two years at Canterbury College, now known as Christ College. Other persons associated with Oxford notable for their influence in our Catholic culture include C.S. Lewis, J.R.R. Tolkien, John Henry Cardinal Newman, and our pilgrimage chaplain, Msgr. Stuart Swetland. From Oxford, we continue to Stratford-Upon-Avon, home of the great playwright, William Shakespeare of whom it has been said, "We'll never know if Shakespeare was Catholic, but his plays express great Christian truths." Dinner today is on your own. Our private Mass today is to be confirmed. Overnight in Stratford-Upon-Avon.

Day 7 June 2 Cambridge - Norwich B, D

Today we drive to Norwich via Cambridge. Bishop St. John Fisher studied at Cambridge University and later served as Vice Chancellor and Chancellor. He was executed by order of Henry VIII for upholding the Church's doctrine of papal primacy. He shares his feast day with St. Thomas More. From there we go on to Norwich, home of the 14th century recluse and mystic, St. Julian of Norwich, known for her book, Revelations of Divine Love. The Cathedral of St. John the Baptist in Norwich is the second largest Catholic Church in England after Westminster Cathedral in London. Our private Mass today is to be confirmed. Group dinner and overnight in the vicinity of Norwich.

Day 8 June 3 Walsingham - London B, D

The final day of pilgrimage begins at the National Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham. We will have time for Mass, private devotions and lunch on your own before returning to London for a Farewell dinner and overnight.

Day 9 June 4 B

Transfer to the airport for our return flight to USA

Breakfast included each in the hotel. Lunch each day is on your own. Dinner as indicated.

Itinerary is subject to change

Further, Trinity Travel advises that it has no ownership interest whatsoever in any hotel, restaurant, bus company or transportation or service company of any kind, nor does it have any employee outside of the USA. You may see the name Trinity Travel affixed to motor vehicles, on signs around the hotel or elsewhere. This use of our name is purely for reasons of identification and does not denote ownership, supervision, or control by Trinity Travel in any way. Trinity Travel acts only as an agent in securing hotels, transportation and other travel services from suppliers, and in no event shall Trinity Travel be liable in the event of any failure by any person or company to render any transportation, lodging or other travel services to be provided on the tour. If there is a difference between the conditions of Trinity Travel and those published by suppliers, the conditions of suppliers shall apply. Trinity Travel and its overseas representatives reserve the right to change, amend or cancel any part or all of the tour; substitute hotels, cruise ships and air carriers of similar quality; and to vary the sequence of sightseeing and/ or to re-route the order of cities; make such other changes as may be reasonably necessary. Trinity Travel may correct pricing errors at any time, or increase the program price in the event of increases due to change in fuel surcharges, currency fluctuations, entrance fees or taxes. In calculating the cost of the trip, Trinity Travel has relied on your consent to these terms and in the absence of this release, the cost of the trip would be higher. A contract is made and these terms are deemed accepted by the tour member when your reservation and initial payment are accepted by Trinity Travel. Any dispute regarding these terms or any other matter related to the services provided by Trinity Travel shall be governed by Kansas law and settled by binding arbitration in Overland Park, KS. We reserve the right to decline to accept a person, or to remove a person from a tour, if such person presents a significant risk to the health or safety of himself or the group and the person cannot otherwise be reasonably accommodated.

Group Air: Group Air reservations are subject to restrictive terms which vary by airline. Connections, layovers, and all conditions surrounding group air travel cannot be guaranteed and may change before departure. Deviations are not allowed on Group Air tickets. To travel on different dates, travelers must book land only (see below) and purchase individual airline flight tickets. Seat assignments for Group Air are made "at the discretion of the airline". Although Trinity Travel will make reasonable effort to fulfill requests, SPECIFIC SEAT ASSIGNMENTS CANNOT AND WILL NOT BE GUARANTEED. Seat numbers will be advised approximately 2 weeks prior to departure. Changes to assigned seats should be discussed directly with the airline. Group Air is economy class and is not upgradable to first class, business, economy plus, etc. To upgrade the class of seat assignment, travelers must book "Land Only" and purchase individual airline flight tickets (see below). Travelers are responsible for complying with all airline requirements for checked and carry-on baggage.

Land Only: Travelers making their own air arrangements will travel "Land Only" and must notify Trinity Travel of no less than 120 days before departure. Land only passengers are responsible for meeting the group at a specified time and location on arrival day and for arranging and the cost of transfers to and from the airport if their schedule does not closely coordinate with the group schedule. **DO NOT PURCHASE INDEPENDENT AIRLINE TICKETS UNTIL NOTIFIED IN WRITING THAT THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF TRAVELERS HAS BEEN MET TO OPERATE THE TRIP.**

Health Requirements: Travelers should be medically and physically fit for this pilgrimage. The pilgrimage requires moderate walking, not always level and sometimes over uneven surfaces. Motor coaches are not always able to drop off passengers close to the site entrances. Some sites may involve stairs and sites are not always wheelchair accessible. Please discuss any existing medical condition prior to booking your reservation.

Photography: Trinity Travel may take photographs of its trips and travelers, and traveler grants express permission to do so and to use such photographs for promotional purposes without compensation to traveler.

Identification Required: A passport is required for all travelers and it should be valid for at least 6 months past the scheduled return date. Non-U.S. citizens may require a visa prior to departure. The cost of passports and any required visa is the responsibility of the traveler.

Cancellation Policy and Refunds: We hope that nothing will prevent you from taking your Trinity Travel pilgrimage. However, should you need to cancel, your cancellation must be received in writing, via email, fax or by letter. It will be effective on the date of receipt. If you cancel your tour after you have received your documents and airline tickets, you must return them to Trinity Travel before we can process your refund. The following cancellation charges per person will apply: within 75 days of deposit - \$175; after 75 days of deposit or after the final payment due date – NO REFUND. Once the tour commences there will be no refunds for missed or unused portions of the tour program. **Trinity Travel recommends that you purchase a travel protection plan to help protect you and your travel investment against the unexpected.** Plan details are available upon request and plan must be purchased at or before the final payment.
